An ITS typically aims to replicate the demonstrated benefits of one-to-one, personalized tutoring, in contexts. ITSs have the common goal of enabling learning in a meaningful and effective manner by using a variety of computing technologies

Pierre-Simon Laplace Laplace also popularized and further confirmed Sir Isaac Newton's work. He summarized and extended the Pierre-Simon, Marquis de Laplace (; French: [pjɛʁ simɔ̃ laplas]; 23 March 1749 – 5 March 1827) was a French polymath, a scholar whose work has been instrumental in the fields of physics, astronomy, mathematics, engineering, statistics, and philosophy. This work translated the geometric study of classical mechanics to one based on calculus, opening up a broader range of problems. He summarized and extended the work of his predecessors in his five-volume *Mécanique céleste* (Celestial Mechanics) (1799–1825). whose work has been instrumental in the fields of physics, astronomy, mathematics, engineering, statistics, and philosophy.
