Glasgow, Dumbarton and Helensburgh Railway It opened in 1858, joining with an earlier local line serving Balloch. Intrinsic in this was the question of how the cities of central Scotland might best be linked with the emerging English railway network. As industry developed other lines were opened to serve it, and the line formed the core of a network in the area. This culminated in The Glasgow, Dumbarton and Helensburgh Railway was independently sponsored to build along the north of the River Clyde. Both were taken over by the powerful North British Railway in 1865, and for some time the line was the main route in the area.

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
