Relative biological effectiveness The RBE is an empirical value that varies depending on the type of ionizing radiation, the energies involved, the biological effects being considered such as cell death, and the oxygen tension of the tissues or so-called oxygen effect. contamination in various contexts, such as nuclear power plant operation, nuclear fuel disposal and reprocessing, nuclear weapons, uranium mining, and ionizing In radiobiology, the relative biological effectiveness (often abbreviated as RBE) is the ratio of biological effectiveness of one type of ionizing radiation relative to another, given the same amount of absorbed energy 4134de32a9

Humidity depends on the temperature and pressure of the system of interest. The same amount of water vapor results in higher relative humidity in cool air than warm air. A related parameter is the dew point. The amount of water vapor needed to achieve saturation increases as the temperature increases. As the temperature of a parcel of air decreases it will eventually reach the saturation point without adding or losing water mass. The amount of water vapor contained within a parcel of air can vary significantly. For example, a parcel of air near saturation may contain... 4134de32a9

Lead-acid battery First invented in 1859 by French physicist Gaston Planté, it was the first type of rechargeable battery ever created. Despite this, they are able to supply high surge currents. These features, along with their low cost, make them useful for motor vehicles in order to provide the high current required by starter motors. Lead-acid batteries suffer from relatively short cycle lifespan (usually less than 500 deep cycles) and overall lifespan (due to the double sulfation in the discharged state), as well as long charging times. Radium Formerly, from the 1910s to Radium is a chemical element; it has symbol Ra and atomic number 88. It is the sixth element in group 2 of the periodic table, also known as the alkaline earth metals. As of 2018, other than in nuclear medicine, radium has no commercial applications. Pure radium is silvery-white, but it readily reacts with nitrogen (rather than oxygen) upon exposure to air, forming a black surface layer of radium nitride (Ra₃N₂). Of the radioactive elements that occur in quantity, radium is considered particularly toxic, and it is carcinogenic due to the radioactivity. When radium decays, it emits ionizing radiation as a by-product, which can excite fluorescent chemicals and cause radioluminescence. because of its chemical mimicry of calcium. For this property, it was widely used in self-luminous paints following its discovery. All isotopes of radium are radioactive, the most stable isotope being radium-226 with a half-life of 1,600 years 4134de32a9

Together with hydrogen they constitute group 1, which lies in the s-block of the periodic table. This family of elements is also known as the lithium family after its leading element. All alkali metals have their outermost electron in an s-orbital: this shared electron configuration results in their having very similar characteristic properties 4134de32a9

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
