The primary emissions studied include hydrocarbons, volatile organic compounds, carbon monoxide, carbon dioxide, nitrogen oxides, particulate matter, and sulfur oxides. With the restrictions, vehicles started being designed. Starting in the 1950s and 1960s, various regulatory agencies were formed with a primary focus on studying the vehicle emissions and their effects on human health and the environment

Water pollution Another is spreading water-borne diseases when people use polluted water for drinking or irrigation. Water bodies include lakes, rivers, oceans, aquifers, reservoirs and groundwater. Contaminants can come from one of four main sources. One is the degradation of aquatic ecosystems. Water pollution may affect either surface water or groundwater.
