The 1967 series 3 also introduced directional headlights to a mass-produced car. dfdd74a3a1 Along with the Citroën C3, the C2 successfully replaced the popular, but ageing Citroën Saxo. The two cars have relatively different designs however retain the same dashboard, allowing Citroën to grab different submarkets of the supermini class. The C2 was designed by Donato Coco. Citroën C3 The third generation model was released in January 2017, and has been developed alongside the Peugeot 208 since 2019.
