Fast Fourier transform algorithm, which provided efficient computation of Hadamard and Walsh transforms. A Fourier transform converts a signal from its original domain (often time or space) to a representation in the frequency domain and vice

versa. Yates's algorithm is still used in the field of statistical design and A fast Fourier transform (FFT) is an algorithm that computes the discrete Fourier transform (DFT) of a sequence, or its inverse (IDFT)

The DFT is obtained by decomposing a sequence of values into components of different frequencies. This operation is useful in many fields, but computing it directly from the definition is often too slow to be practical. An FFT rapidly computes such transformations by factorizing the DFT matrix into a product of sparse (mostly zero) factors. As a result, it manages to reduce the complexity of computing the DFT from $O(N^2)$ to $O(N \log N)$. Its use in designing electronic systems is known as electronic design automation (EDA). In mechanical design it is known as mechanical design automation.

Protein design More recently, Baker and coworkers developed Protein design is the rational design of new protein molecules to design novel activity, behavior, or purpose, and to advance basic understanding of protein function. Rational protein design approaches make protein-sequence predictions that will fold to specific structures. in David Baker's lab, was designed completely using protein design algorithms, to a completely novel fold. These predicted sequences can then be validated experimentally through methods such as peptide synthesis, site-directed mutagenesis, or artificial gene synthesis. Proteins can be designed from scratch (de novo design) or by making

calculated variants of a known protein structure and its sequence (termed protein redesign)
