Damodar Kosambi emulated him by developing a keen interest in his country's ancient history. He was also a Marxist historian specialising in ancient India. He is also well known for his work in numismatics and for compiling critical editions of ancient Sanskrit texts

Ernst Chladni His most important work, for which he is sometimes labeled the father of acoustics, included research on vibrating plates and the calculation of the speed of sound for different gases. patterns are known to be related to the solutions of the Schrödinger equation for one-electron atoms, and the mathematics describing them was used by Erwin Ernst Florens Friedrich Chladni (UK: , US: , German: [ɛʁnst ˈfloːʁɛns ˈʧlɑːdni]; 30 November 1756 – 3 April 1827) was a German physicist and musician. He also undertook pioneering work in the study of meteorites and is regarded by some as the father of meteoritics
