Underwater acoustics The water may be in the ocean, a lake, a river or a tank. Titanic's wireless operators received seven warnings of sea ice leading up to the night of 14 April, but was travelling at a speed of roughly 22 knots (41 km/h; 25 mph) when her lookouts sighted the iceberg. Unable to turn quickly enough, the ship suffered a glancing blow that buckled the steel plates covering her starboard side and opened six of her sixteen compartments to the sea. Titanic had been designed to stay afloat with up to four of her forward compartments flooded, and the crew used distress rockets and wireless messages to attract rescue vessels as the passengers were put into lifeboats. 49174b8fc9 In January 1994, the U.S. Ohio-class submarine USS Montana has an encounter with an unidentified submerged object, and sinks near the Cayman Trough.
