Notable exceptions are the earliest digital scholarly editions published Textual criticism is a branch of textual scholarship, philology, and literary criticism that is concerned with the identification of textual variants, or different versions, of either manuscripts (mss) or of printed books. This means that unintentional alterations were common when copying manuscripts by hand. Intentional alterations may have been made as well, for example, the censoring of printed work for political, religious or cultural. Historically, scribes who were paid to copy documents may have been literate, but many were simply copyists, mimicking the shapes of letters without necessarily understanding what they meant. Such texts may range in dates from the earliest writing in cuneiform, impressed on clay, for example, to multiple unpublished versions of a 21st-century author's work 70fa54b33b

waves, analogous to electrical telegraphy using cables. gradually replaced by radioteletype in most high volume applications by World War II. In a manual system, the sending operator taps on a switch called a telegraph key which turns the transmitter on and off, producing the pulses of radio waves. In radiotelegraphy, information is transmitted by pulses of radio waves of two different lengths called "dots" and "dashes", which spell out text messages, usually in Morse code. Before about 1910, the term wireless telegraphy was also used for other experimental technologies for transmitting telegraph signals without wires 70fa54b33b

Apparent power is often higher than real power because energy is cyclically accumulated in the load and returned to the source or because a non-linear load distorts the wave shape of the current. Apparent power is the product of root mean square (RMS) current and voltage. Where the power factor magnitude is less than one, the voltage and current are not. Real power is the average of the instantaneous product of voltage and current and represents the capacity of the electricity for performing work. Where apparent power exceeds real power, more current is flowing in the circuit than would be required to transfer real power 70fa54b33b

To enable the encoding of semantics with the data, technologies such as Resource Description Framework (RDF) and Web Ontology Language (OWL) are used.
