Halting problem always answers "halts" and another that always answers "does not halt". The halting problem is undecidable, meaning that no general algorithm exists that solves the halting problem for all possible program-input pairs. The problem comes up often in discussions of computability since it demonstrates that some functions are mathematically definable but not computable. For any specific program and input, one of these two algorithms answers correctly. In computability theory, the halting problem is the problem of determining, from a description of an arbitrary computer program and an input, whether the program will finish running, or continue to run forever.

Hilbert problems, numbers 3, 7, 10, 14, 17, 18, 19, 20, and 21 have resolutions that are accepted by consensus of the mathematical community. They were all unsolved at the time, and several proved to be very influential for 20th-century mathematics. The complete list of 23 problems was published later, in English translation in 1902 by Mary Frances Winston Newson in the Bulletin of the American Mathematical Society. Problems 1, 2 Hilbert's problems are 23 problems in mathematics published by German mathematician David Hilbert in 1900.
