British Informatics Olympiad Any student under 19 who is The British Informatics Olympiad (BIO) is an annual computer-programming competition for secondary and sixth-form students. In the past, there also existed written problems, but these have been phased out in recent years. Any student under 19 who is in full-time pre-university education and resident in mainland Britain is eligible to compete. Typically a score of 75 to 90 out of 100 is required on the first round of the competition to reach the final. The top-15 performing students each year are invited to the finals (currently hosted by Trinity College, Cambridge) where they attempt to solve several more difficult problems, involving programming. The competition is composed of two rounds - a preliminary 3-question, 3-hour exam paper sat at the participant's school and a final round.
