Unmetalled roads, also known as gravel roads or dirt roads, are rough and can sustain less weight. In the past, gravel road surfaces, macadam, hoggins, cobblestone and granite setts were extensively used, but these have mostly been replaced by asphalt or concrete laid on a compacted base course. Modern paving methods and design methods have changed the economics of concrete paving so that a well-designed and placed concrete pavement will be cheaper. A road surface (British English) or pavement (North American English) is the durable surface material laid down on an area intended to sustain vehicular or foot traffic, such as a road or walkway. Road surfaces are frequently marked to. Its foundations can be traced back to Karl Marx's critique of political economy. Marxian economics comprises several different theories and includes multiple schools of thought, which are sometimes opposed to each other; in many cases Marxian analysis is used to complement, or to supplement, other economic approaches. Marx's theory of value differs from the classical view in his definition of labor. However, unlike critics of political economy, Marxian economists tend to accept the concept of the economy *prima facie*. An example can be found in the works of Soviet economists like Lev Gatovsky, who sought to apply Marxist economic theory to the objectives, needs, and political conditions of the socialist construction in the Soviet Union, contributing to the development 63cccb835a
