Action research The field is supported by a quarterly Action research is a philosophy and methodology of research generally applied in the social sciences. It seeks transformative change through the simultaneous process of taking action and doing research, which are linked together by critical reflection. Kurt Lewin, then a professor at MIT, first coined the term "action research" in 1944. In his 1946 paper "Action Research and Minority Problems" he described action research as "a comparative research on the conditions and effects of various forms of social action and research leading to social action" that uses "a spiral of steps, each of which is composed of a circle of planning, action and fact-finding about the result of the action". Prime number If so, it answers yes and otherwise it answers no. For example, 5 is prime because the only ways of writing it as a product, 1×5 or 5×1 , involve 5 itself. Primes are central in number theory because of the fundamental theorem of arithmetic: every natural number greater than 1 is either a prime itself or can be factorized as a product of primes that is unique up to their order. However, 4 is composite because it is a product (2×2) in which both numbers are smaller than 4. A natural number greater than 1 that is not prime is called a composite number. If p really is prime, it will always answer yes, but if p is a prime number (or a prime) is a natural number greater than 1 that is not a product of two smaller natural numbers. p
