A moving charge in a magnetic A magnetic field (sometimes called B-field) is a physical field that describes the

magnetic influence on moving electric charges, electric currents, and magnetic materials. A moving charge in a magnetic field experiences a force perpendicular to its own velocity and to the magnetic field. Induction motor An induction motor or asynchronous motor is an AC electric motor in which the electric current in the rotor that produces torque is obtained by electromagnetic induction from the magnetic field of the stator winding. Spark-gap transmitter Spark-gap transmitters were the first type of radio transmitter, and were the main type used during the wireless telegraphy or "spark" era, the first three decades of radio, from 1887 to the end of World War I. resonant circuits (tuned circuits or tank circuits) which create radio frequency electrical oscillations when excited by the spark. German physicist Heinrich Hertz built the first experimental spark-gap transmitters in 1887, with which
