Scale insect Of dramatically variable appearance and extreme sexual dimorphism, they comprise the infraorder Coccoomorpha which is considered a more convenient grouping than the superfamily Coccoidea due to taxonomic uncertainties. Some species are hermaphroditic, with a combined ovotestis instead of separate ovaries and testes. Scale insects are small insects of the order Hemiptera, suborder Sternorrhyncha. The excess fluid they imbibe is secreted as honeydew. Scale insects are herbivores, piercing plant tissues with their mouthparts and remaining in one place, feeding on sap. Males, in the species where they occur, have legs and sometimes wings, and resemble small flies. Adult females typically have soft bodies and no limbs, and are concealed underneath domed scales, extruding quantities of wax for protection. Insect morphology The terminology used to describe insects is similar to that used for other arthropods due to their shared evolutionary history. The terminology used to describe insects is similar to that used for other Insect morphology is the study and description of the physical form of insects. Insect morphology is the study and description of the physical form of insects. Three physical features separate insects from other arthropods: they have a body divided into three regions (called tagmata) (head, thorax, and abdomen), three pairs of legs, and mouthparts located outside of the head capsule. This position of the mouthparts divides them from their closest relatives, the non-insect hexapods, which include Protura, Diplura, and Collembola 22e3878fb3

Academically, the interaction of insects and society has been treated in part as cultural entomology, dealing mostly

with "advanced" societies, and in part as ethnoentomology, dealing mostly with "primitive" societies, though the distinction is weak and not based on theory. Both academic disciplines explore the parallels, connections and influence of insects on human populations, and vice versa.
