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Hervey M. 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New Deal Roosevelt introduced the phrase upon accepting the Democratic Party's presidential nomination in 1932 before winning the election in a landslide over incumbent Herbert Hoover, whose administration was viewed by many as doing too little to help those affected. While Milton Friedman and Anna Schwartz argued in *A Monetary History of the United States* (1963) The New Deal was a series of wide-reaching economic, social, and political reforms enacted by President Franklin D.
