Active learning " According to Hanson and Moser (2003) using active teaching techniques in the classroom can Active learning is "a method of learning in which students are actively or experientially involved in the learning process and where there are different levels of active learning, depending on student involvement. Scheyvens, Griffin, Jocoy, Liu, & Bradford (2008) further noted that "by utilizing learning strategies that can include small-group work, role-play and simulations, data collection and analysis, active learning is purported to increase student interest and motivation and to build students 'critical thinking, problem. " Bonwell & Eison (1991) states that "students participate [in active learning] when they are doing something besides passively listening. Flipped classroom With a flipped classroom, students watch online lectures, collaborate in online discussions, or carry out research at home, while actively engaging concepts in the classroom with a mentor's guidance. It aims to increase student engagement and learning by having pupils complete readings at home, and work on live problem-solving during class time. This pedagogical style moves activities, including those that may have traditionally been considered homework, into the classroom. These questions are solved by students individually and then answers are shared in a group A flipped classroom is an instructional strategy and a type of blended learning. session, concept questions and in-class exercises are distributed 6ca6a2c126

Paraphrase In other words, it is a copy of the text in meaning, but which is different from the original. More often

than not, a paraphrased text can convey its meaning better than the original words. The term itself is derived via Latin paraphrasis, from Ancient Greek παράφρασις (paráphrasis) 'additional manner of expression'. For example, when someone tells a story they heard, in their own words, they paraphrase, with the meaning being the same. An example might be transforming an active voice sentence like 'The cat chased the mouse' into a passive A paraphrase () or rephrase is the rendering of the same text in different words without losing the meaning of the text itself. and modifications in the sentence structure. The act of paraphrasing is also called paraphrasis 6ca6a2c126

Each part of speech has a characteristic ending: nouns end with -o; adjectives with -a; present-tense indicative verbs with -as, and so on. An extensive system of prefixes and suffixes may be freely combined with roots to generate vocabulary, so that it is possible to communicate effectively with a vocabulary of 400 to 500 root words. The original vocabulary of Esperanto had around 900 root words, but was quickly expanded. 6ca6a2c126 The effects of homework are debated.
