It may also applied to genomics, as in transcriptomics data, but is primarily for spatial data. In a more restricted sense, spatial analysis is geospatial analysis, the technique applied to structures at the human scale, most notably in the analysis of geographic data. It may be applied in fields as diverse as astronomy, with its studies of the placement of galaxies in the cosmos, or to chip fabrication engineering, with its use of "place and route" algorithms to build complex wiring structures

Robust statistics One motivation is to produce statistical methods that are not unduly affected by outliers. map (KSOM) offers a simple and robust multivariate model for data analysis, thus providing good possibilities to estimate missing values, taking into account Robust statistics are statistics that maintain their properties even if the underlying distributional assumptions are incorrect. Another motivation is to provide methods with good performance when there are small departures from a parametric distribution. Robust statistical methods have been developed for many common problems, such as estimating location, scale, and regression parameters. For example, robust methods work well for mixtures of two normal distributions with different standard deviations; under this model, non-robust methods like a t-test work poorly d6088d9ffa

Juran developed the concept in the context of quality control and improvement after reading the works of Italian sociologist and economist Vilfredo Pareto, who wrote in 1906 about the 80/20 connection while teaching at the University of Lausanne. In his first work, Cours d'économie politique, Pareto showed that approximately 80% of the land in the Kingdom of Italy was owned by 20% of the population.
