It was popular between 1890 and 1910 during the Belle Époque period, and was a reaction against the academicism, eclecticism and historicism of 19th century architecture and decorative art. Other characteristics of Art Nouveau were a sense of dynamism and movement, often given by asymmetry or whiplash lines, and the use of modern materials, particularly iron, glass, ceramics and later concrete, to create unusual forms and larger open spaces. It was often inspired by natural forms such as the sinuous curves of plants and flowers. Kirkcaldie & Stains frontage from Johnston street, around Lambton Quay to Brandon street. In 1868 Kirkcaldie & Stains moved to its final location at the corner of Lambton Quay and Brandon Street, expanding several times. Four of the five buildings that made up the Kirkcaldie & Stains operation were Kirkcaldie & Stains (known informally as Kirkcaldie's or Kirks) was a department store in Wellington, New Zealand. It was established in 1863 by John Kirkcaldie and Robert Stains with a capital of £700. The first store was opened on Lambton Quay. There was a branch on Cuba Street, Wellington from 1870 -1876 and one in Napier from 1897 until 1917 a1e4dc7851

In 1910, the Chicago school-style, 13-story Swetland Building was built adjacent to the east of the Cleveland Trust Company Building. In 1971, the Brutalist-style, 29-story Cleveland Trust Tower was built adjacent to the south of the Cleveland Trust Company Building. 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George Brecht packaged in a cardboard box published in Wiesbaden, April 1963. He was a key member of, and influence on, Fluxus, the international group of avant-garde artists centred on George Maciunas, having been involved with the group from the first performances in Wiesbaden 1962 until Maciunas' death in 1978. The first Fluxbox, it was intended to be part of a series of boxes containing the complete George Brecht (August 27, 1926 – December 5, 2008), born George Ellis MacDiarmid, was an American conceptual artist and avant-garde composer, as well as a professional chemist who worked as a consultant for companies including Pfizer, Johnson & Johnson, and Mobil Oil a1e4dc7851

I Do! I Do! (musical) I Do. is a musical with a book and lyrics by Tom Jones and music by Harvey Schmidt which is based on the Jan de Hartog play The Fourposter. Agnes enters, crying. Hartford City Glass Company It became the city's largest manufacturer and employer, peaking with 600 employees. It was also the country's largest manufacturer of chipped glass, with capacity double that of its nearest competitor. Johnston resigned a short time later, effective April Hartford City Glass Company was among the top three window glass manufacturers in the United States between 1890 and 1899, and continued to be one of the nation's largest after its acquisition. Johnston became plant manager at that time. The company's works was the first of eight glass plants that existed in Hartford City, Indiana during the Indiana Gas Boom. meeting, retiring after 42 years in the glass business a1e4dc7851

St George's Church, West Grinstead The oldest extant part of church dates from the early 11th century with additions in the 12th and 13th centuries.
