The earlier name for the god was Hades, which became more common as the name of the underworld itself. The couple received souls in the afterlife and are invoked together in religious inscriptions. Pluto represents a more positive concept of the god who presides over the afterlife. Ploutōn was frequently conflated with Ploûtos, the Greek god of wealth, because mineral wealth was found underground, and because as a chthonic god Pluto ruled the deep earth that contained the seeds necessary for a bountiful harvest b18d3232aa
