Grade inflation However, higher average grades in themselves do not prove grade inflation. For this to be grade inflation, it is necessary to demonstrate that the quality of work does not deserve the high grade. a Mathematics exam sat the O-Level and 64% the CSE paper. With grades allocated on a normative basis with approximately ~53% (10% A, 15% B, 25–30% C) Grade inflation (also known as grading leniency) is the general awarding of higher grades for the same quality of work over time, which devalues grades fe7df8cf61
