Logarithm More generally, if $x = by$, then y is the logarithm of x to base b , written $\log_b x$, so $\log_{10} 1000 = 3$. As a single-variable function, the logarithm to base b is the inverse of exponentiation with base b . $_b x = \frac{1}{x \ln b}$
