Established on 9 July 1860 by Florence Nightingale, the founder of modern nursing, it was a model for many similar training schools through the UK, Commonwealth and other countries for the latter half of the 19th century. Nurse practitioner NPs are trained to assess patient needs, order and interpret diagnostic and laboratory tests, diagnose disease, prescribe medications and formulate treatment plans. of nursing practice to be able to serve as primary care providers. Certified registered nurse anesthetist Historically, nurses have been providing anesthesia care to patients for over 160 years, dating back to the American Civil War (1861–1865). CRNA schools issue a Doctorate of nursing anesthesia degree to nurses who have completed a program in anesthesia, which is 3 years in length. The CRNA credential was formally established in 1956.
