From late 1942 to early 1943, it was tasked with intercepting incoming raids mounted by Luftwaffe fighter

bombers. It was then switched to offensive operations, escorting bombers attacking targets in France and then flying in a fighter bomber role. In early 1944 the squadron re-equipped with the Hawker Tempest. In the run up to D-Day, it attacked numerous military targets in France and the Low Countries.
