In general, an ISA defines the instructions, data types, registers, the hardware support for managing main memory, fundamental features (such as the memory consistency, addressing modes, virtual memory), and the input/output model of the programmable interface. The definition is often extended with the requirement that the treatment of programs and data in memory be interchangeable or uniform.
