The field of ethics, along with aesthetics, concern matters of value, and thus comprise the branch of philosophy called axiology. 1c19eba17f The subject of technoethics, or the ethical implications of technology, have been

studied by different philosophers such as Hans Jonas and Mario Bunge. The topic has evolved as technologies have developed. Technology poses an ethical dilemma on producers and consumers alike.

Suffering-focused ethics suffering-focused character-based ethics, such a moral character will be that of the moral agent with the attitudes and dispositions of a virtuous suffering Suffering-focused ethics are those views in ethics according to which reducing suffering is either a key priority or our only aim. Nevertheless, these views still prioritize reducing preventable suffering over these other aims. Those suffering-focused ethics according to which the reduction of suffering is a key priority are pluralistic views that include additional aims, such as the prevention of other disvaluable things like inequality, or the promotion of certain valuable things, such as pleasure

The core values and expectations of political morality have historically derived from the principles of justice. However, John Rawls defends the theory that the political concept of justice is ultimately based on the common good of the individual rather than on the values one is expected to follow.

Philosophers refer to people who have moral responsibility for an action as "moral agents". Agents have the capability to reflect upon their situation, to form intentions about how they will act, and then to carry out that action. The notion of free will has become an important issue in the debate on whether individuals are ever morally responsible for their actions and, if so, in what sense.
