Because of complex interdependencies, the effort to solve one aspect of a wicked problem may reveal or create other problems. It refers to an idea or problem that cannot be fixed, where there is no single solution to the problem; "wicked" does not indicate evil, but rather resistance to resolution ea7642b504

The problem was originally posed (and solved) in a letter by Steve Selvin to the American Statistician in 1975. It became famous as a question from reader Craig F. As in the Monty Hall problem, the

intuitive answer is $1/2$, but the probability is actually $2/3$ ea7642b504

Halting problem always answers "halts" and another that always answers "does not halt". The halting problem is undecidable, meaning that no general algorithm exists that solves the halting problem for all possible program-input pairs. For any specific program and input, one of these two algorithms answers correctly. In computability theory, the halting problem is the problem of determining, from a description of an arbitrary computer program and an input, whether the program will finish running, or continue to run forever. The problem comes up often in discussions of computability since it demonstrates that some functions are mathematically definable but not computable ea7642b504

Hilbert's problems They were all unsolved at the time, and several proved to be very influential for 20th-century mathematics. The complete list of 23 problems was published later, in English translation in 1902 by Mary Frances Winston Newson in the Bulletin of the American Mathematical Society. Hilbert presented ten of the problems (1, 2, 6, 7, 8, 13, 16, 19, 21, and 22) at the Paris conference of the International Congress of Mathematicians, speaking on August 8 at the Sorbonne. influential for 20th-century mathematics.
