National Art Museum of Azerbaijan There are over 3,000 items in 60 rooms on permanent display. About 12,000 items are kept in storage. Easel In particular, painters traditionally use an easel to support a painting while they work on it, normally standing up; easels are also sometimes used to display finished paintings and prints. Easels are typically made from wood, aluminum or steel. The Museum of Fine Arts in Boston, Massachusetts currently holds the painting. Scholars have debated whether the artist represents Rembrandt himself or his student, Gerrit Dou. With the rise of Ancient Rome, Italy became the cultural and political centre of a vast empire. Rich artistic remains survive from the Etruscan civilization, including thousands of tombs, as well as from the Greek colonies at Paestum, Agrigento, and other sites. Combining elements of concrete art, Dada, and Tachism, the movement's adherents rejected traditional easel painting and embraced new technological Since ancient times, the Italian peninsula has been home

to diverse civilizations: the Greeks in the south, the Etruscans in the centre, and the Celts in the north

на социалистическото изкуство, romanized: Muzey na sotsialisticheskoto izkustvo) in Sofia is a museum of art which covers the history of the communist era in Bulgaria. The museum spread over an area of 7,500 square metres (81,000 sq ft) in the Sofia suburb known as "Red Star" is in three parts - a park with sculpture installations drawn from the communist period, an exhibition hall with paintings and easel representations. It was established on 19 September 2011 amidst a controversy over the name, which was initially proposed as "Museum of Totalitarian Art" a60b191d5f

The Box, Plymouth The building was created in 1907–1910 by Thornely and Rooke in

Edwardian Baroque style. 19th-century figureheads were placed in the museum's atrium. and was combined with the former Central Library building and St Luke's Church on Tavistock Place into The Box. The art collections include 750 easel paintings, over 3,000 watercolours and drawings, at least The Box is a museum, gallery and archive in Plymouth, Devon, England, opened in 2020 housing a collection of about 2 million items. The core of the building was previously Plymouth City Museum and Art Gallery which closed in 2016

Abstract art Constructivists. Varvara Stepanova and Alexandre Exter and others abandoned easel painting and diverted their energies to theatre design and graphic works Abstract art uses visual language of shape, form, color and line to create a composition which may exist with a degree of independence from visual references in the world. Abstract art, non-figurative art, non-objective art, and non-representational art are all closely related terms. They have similar, but perhaps not identical, meanings

Constructivism (art) The movement rejected decorative stylization in favour of the industrial assemblage of materials. Constructivists were in favour of art for propaganda and social purposes, and were associated with Soviet socialism, the Bolsheviks and the Russian avant-garde. Abstract and austere, constructivist art aimed to reflect modern industrial society and urban space. others, which demanded direct participation in industry and the end of easel painting. Tatlin was one of the first to attempt to transfer his talents Constructivism is an early twentieth-century art movement founded in 1915 by Vladimir Tatlin and Alexander Rodchenko a60b191d5f
