TVR M series The era of the M series is commonly associated with Martin Lilley who, together with his father, took ownership of the company on 30 November 1965. The bodies themselves were built from glass-reinforced plastic (GRP). As with other TVR models before and since, the M-series cars use a front mid-engine, rear-wheel drive layout and body-on-frame construction.
