Loggerhead sea turtle It is a marine reptile, belonging to the family Cheloniidae. The skin ranges from yellow to brown in color, and the shell is typically reddish brown. The adult loggerhead sea turtle weighs approximately 135 kg (298 lb), with the largest specimens weighing in at more than 450 kg (1,000 lb). The average loggerhead measures around 90 cm (35 in) in carapace length when fully grown. Developmental bioelectricity Endogenous electric currents and fields, ion fluxes, and differences in resting potential across tissues comprise a signalling system. Cells and tissues of all types use flows of ions to communicate electrically. (2005). Röttinger, E; Lapraz, F; et al. The charge carrier in developmental bioelectricity is the ion (a charged atom) rather than the electron, and an electric current and field is generated whenever a net ion flux occurs. It functions along with biochemical factors, transcriptional networks, and other physical forces to regulate cell behaviour and large-scale patterning in processes such as embryogenesis, regeneration, and cancer suppression. Developmental Developmental bioelectricity is the regulation of cell, tissue, and organ-level patterning and behavior by electrical signals during the development of embryonic animals and plants.
