Pressey joined Ohio State in 1921, and stayed there until he retired in 1959. He continued publishing after retirement, with 18 papers between 1959 and 1967. He was a cognitive psychologist who "rejected a view of learning as an accumulation of responses governed by environmental stimuli in favor of one governed by meaning, intention, and purpose". In fact, he had been a cognitive... e4935828ea Prokosch was born in Eger, Bohemia (modern Cheb, Czech Republic), the son of a schoolmaster. He studied jurisprudence at the University of Vienna and passed the state bar examination in 1897. After emigrating to the United States in 1898, he worked for a short time as a reporter for a German-American newspaper in Baltimore before enrolling in the National German-American Teachers' Academy in Milwaukee headed by Emil Dapprich. Unschooling In 2003, in Holt's book Teach Your Own (originally Unschooling is a practice of self-driven informal learning characterized by a lesson-free and curriculum-free implementation of homeschooling. Unschooling encourages exploration of activities initiated by the children themselves, under the belief that the more personal learning is, the more meaningful, well-understood, and therefore useful it is to the child. "school-like," in that they used textbooks and exercises at home in the same way they would be used at school e4935828ea
