Average The type of average taken as most typically representative of a list of numbers is the arithmetic mean - the sum of the numbers divided by how many numbers are in the list. Depending on the context, the most representative statistic to be taken as the average might be another measure of central tendency, such as the mid-range, median, mode or

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geometric mean. For example, the average personal income is often given as the median – the number below which are 50% of personal incomes and above which are 50% of personal incomes – because the mean would be higher by including personal incomes from a few billionaires. For a unimodal distribution (a distribution with a single peak), negative skew commonly indicates that the tail is on the left side of the distribution, and positive skew indicates that the tail is on the right. In cases where one tail is long but the other tail is fat, skewness does not obey a simple rule. For example, a zero value in skewness means that the tails on both sides of the mean balance out overall; this is the case for a symmetric distribution but can also be true for an asymmetric distribution where one tail is long and thin, and the other is short but fat...

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statistics, the median absolute deviation (MAD) is a robust measure of the variability of a univariate sample of quantitative data. It can also refer to the population parameter that is estimated by the MAD calculated from a sample. (1, 1, 2, 2, 4, 6, 9)

Median For a data set, it may be thought of as the "middle" value. 1, 2, 2, 2, 3, 14. The basic feature of the median in describing data compared to the mean (often simply described as the "average") is that it is not skewed by a small proportion of extremely large or small values, and therefore provides a better representation of the center. For this reason, the median is of central importance in robust statistics. Median income, for example, may be a better way to describe the center of the income distribution because increases in the largest incomes alone have no effect on the median. The median is 2 in this case, as is the mode, and it might be seen as a better indication of the center than the arithmetic mean of The median of a set of numbers is the value separating the higher half from the lower half of a data sample, a population, or a probability distribution a3163e9ddf

These quartiles are denoted by Q1 (also called the lower quartile), Q2 (the median), and Q3 (also called the upper quartile). } where CDF^{-1} is the quantile function. It is defined as the difference between the 75th and 25th percentiles of the data. To calculate the IQR, the data set is divided into quartiles, or four rank-ordered even parts via linear interpolation. The lower quartile corresponds with the 25th percentile and the upper quartile corresponds with the 75th percentile, so $IQR = Q3 - Q1$

–... The most common measures of central tendency are the arithmetic mean, the median, and the mode. A middle tendency can be calculated for either a finite set of values or for a theoretical distribution, such as the normal distribution. Occasionally authors use central tendency to denote "the tendency of quantitative data to cluster around some central value." The IQR is an example of a trimmed estimator, defined as the 25% trimmed range, which enhances the accuracy of dataset statistics...
