Hoppe has written extensively in opposition to democracy, notably in his 2001 book *Democracy: The God That Failed*. The book favors exclusionary "covenant communities" that are "founded for the purpose of protecting family and kin". A section of the book favoring exclusion of democrats and homosexuals from society helped popularize Hoppe on the far-right. Murray's work is highly controversial. His book *Losing Ground: American Social Policy, 1950–1980* (1984) discussed the American welfare system. In the book *The Bell Curve* (1994), he and co-author Richard Herrnstein argue that in 20th-century American society, intelligence became a better predictor than parental socioeconomic status or education level of many individual outcomes, including income, job performance, pregnancy out of wedlock, and crime, and that social welfare programs and education efforts to improve social outcomes for the disadvantaged are largely counterproductive. *The Bell Curve* also...
