For any specific program and input, one of these two algorithms answers correctly In computability theory, the halting problem is the problem of determining, from a description of an arbitrary computer program and an input, whether the program will finish running, or continue to run forever. The problem comes up often in discussions of computability since it demonstrates that some functions are mathematically definable but not computable

Boolean algebra Algebra of Classes and Propositional Calculus. Elementary algebra, on the other hand, uses arithmetic operators such as addition, multiplication, subtraction, and division. First, the values of the variables are the truth values true and false, usually denoted by 1 and 0, whereas in elementary algebra the values of the variables are numbers. Second, Boolean algebra uses logical operators such as conjunction (and) denoted as $\wedge$, disjunction (or) denoted as $\vee$, and negation (not) denoted as $\neg$.
