There have been several deprecated components as well, such as the Jet Database Engine, MSDASQL (the OLE DB provider for ODBC), and Remote Data Services (RDS). Its components include: ActiveX Data Objects (ADO), OLE DB, and Open Database Connectivity (ODBC). Introduced in the 1970s, SQL offered two main advantages over older read-write APIs such as ISAM or VSAM. Firstly, it introduced the concept of accessing many records with one single command.
