Slide guitar The guitar may also be placed on the player's lap and played with a hand-held bar (lap steel. The strings are typically plucked (not strummed) while the slide is moved over the strings to change the pitch. Slide guitar is a technique for playing the guitar that is often used in blues music. It involves playing a guitar while holding a hard object (a slide) against the strings, creating the opportunity for glissando effects and deep vibratos that reflect characteristics of the human singing voice. The slide may be a metal or glass tube, such as the neck of a bottle, giving rise to the term bottleneck guitar to describe this type of playing. Acoustic guitar An acoustic guitar is a musical instrument in the string family. When a string is plucked, its vibration is transmitted from the bridge, resonating throughout the top of the guitar. Typically, a guitar's body is a sound box, of which the top side serves as a sound board that enhances the vibration sounds of the strings. It is also transmitted to the side and back of the instrument, resonating through the air in the body, and producing sound from the sound hole. In standard tuning the guitar's six strings are tuned (low to high) E2 A2 D3 G3 B3 E4. Steel guitar Conceptually, it is somewhat akin to playing a guitar with one finger (the bar). Typically, the strings are plucked (not strummed) by the fingers of the dominant hand, while the steel tone bar is pressed lightly against the strings and moved by the opposite hand. The bar itself is called a "steel" and is the source of the name "steel guitar". Known for its smooth, gliding glissandi over every pitch between notes, the instrument can produce a sinuous crying sound and deep vibrato emulating the human singing voice. The instrument differs from a conventional guitar in that it has no frets— but markers that look like frets.
