These classes are Grade I, Grade II, Grade III, Grade IV, and Grade V(Grade Names Changed as of Jan 2017). The sport has eligible classifications for people with physical and vision disabilities. The para-equestrian classification does not consider the gender of the rider, as equestrians. The para-equestrian Para-equestrian classification is a system for para-equestrian sport. It is a graded system based on the degree of physical or visual disability and handled at the international level by the FEI. to allow fair competition.
