Ethylene oxide is a colorless and flammable gas with a faintly sweet odor. It is a cyclic ether and the simplest epoxide: a three-membered ring consisting of one oxygen atom and two carbon atoms. Ethylene oxide is isomeric with acetaldehyde and with vinyl alcohol. Ethylene oxide is industrially produced by oxidation of ethylene in the presence of a silver catalyst

It is a colorless, odorless solid, highly soluble in water, and practically non-toxic (LD50 is 15 g/kg for rats). Dissolved in water, it is neither acidic nor alkaline. The body uses it in many processes, most notably nitrogen excretion. The...

Lomustine It is a highly lipid-soluble drug, thus it crosses the blood-brain barrier. It is closely related to semustine and is in the same family as streptozotocin. This property makes it ideal for treating brain tumors, which is its primary use, although it is also used to treat Hodgkin lymphoma as a second-line option. Productivity The key source of difference between various productivity measures is also usually related (directly or indirectly) to how the outputs and the inputs. often expressed as a ratio of an aggregate output to a single input or an aggregate input used in a production process, i. productivity (or income accounting) this means that the omitted input can be used unlimitedly in production without any impact on accounting results. Because Productivity is the efficiency of production of goods or services expressed by some measure. e.
