The Ford Laser was a restyled version of the Familia/323 models produced by Mazda in Japan from 1980 onwards. This generation marked several firsts for the model line, including the introduction of the Ford Blue Oval grille emblem, the introduction of a diesel engine to the model line, and a dashboard with a full set of instruments (optional).
