With American assistance, in 1972 the RVNN became the largest Southeast Asian navy and, by some estimates, the fourth largest navy in the world, just behind the Soviet Union, the United States and the People's Republic of China, with 42,000 personnel, 672 amphibious ships and craft, 20 mine warfare vessels, 450 patrol craft, 56 service craft, and 242 junks. The early fleet consisted of boats from France under the State of Vietnam; after 1955, and the transfer of the armed forces to Vietnamese control, the fleet was supplied from the United States. Human trafficking in Niger two NGOs in 2009, 138 were Nigerien, and the remaining 77 children were from neighboring countries. Children are trafficked within Niger for forced begging by religious instructors known as marabouts; forced labor in gold mines, agriculture, and stone quarries; as well as for involuntary domestic servitude and forced prostitution. The ILO estimates at least 10,000 children work in gold mines in Niger, many of whom may have been forced to work. Caste-based slavery practices, rooted in ancestral master-slave relationships, continued primarily in the northern part of the country.
