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Little is known about Bahu's life, other than what was written in a hagiography called *Manaqib-i Sultani* seven generations after Bahu's own time. According to these records, he was born in Shorkot into the Awan tribe. He was son of Bayazid Muhammad, an officer in the Mughal Army, and Rasti.
