Prime number Primes are used in several routines in information technology, such as public-key cryptography, which A prime number (or a prime) is a natural number greater than 1 that is not a product of two smaller natural numbers. focusing on analytic or algebraic aspects of numbers. However, 4 is composite because it is a product (2×2) in which both numbers are smaller than 4. Primes are central in number theory because of the fundamental theorem of arithmetic: every natural number greater than 1 is either a prime itself or can be factorized as a product of primes that is unique up to their order. For example, 5 is prime because the only ways of writing it as a product, 1×5 or 5×1 , involve 5 itself. A natural number greater than 1 that is not prime is called a composite number 475408a0f2
