Turing test The results would not depend on the machine's ability to answer questions correctly, only on how closely its answers resembled those of a

human. In the test, a human evaluator judges a text transcript of a natural-language conversation between a human and a machine. The Turing test, originally called the imitation game by Alan Turing in 1949, is a test of a machine's ability to exhibit intelligent behaviour equivalent to that of a human. Since the Turing test is a test of indistinguishability in performance capacity, the verbal version generalizes naturally to all of human performance capacity, verbal as well as nonverbal (robotic). The evaluator tries to identify the machine, and the machine passes if the evaluator cannot reliably tell them apart

COVID-19 testing Molecular tests for viral presence through its molecular components are used to diagnose individual cases and to allow public health authorities to trace and contain outbreaks. They are less useful for diagnosing current infections because antibodies may not develop for weeks after infection. It is used to assess disease prevalence, which aids the estimation of the infection fatality rate.
