Norman Lloyd He worked in every major facet of the industry, including theatre, radio, television, and film, with a career that started in 1923. Gottlob Frege He was a mathematics professor at the University of Jena, and is understood by many to be the father of analytic philosophy, concentrating on the philosophy of language, logic, and mathematics. geometry), Ernst Christian Julius Schering (1824–1897; function theory), Wilhelm Eduard Weber (1804–1891; physical studies, applied physics), Eduard Riecke Friedrich Ludwig Gottlob Frege (; German: [ˈɡɔtloːp ˈfreːgə]; 8 November 1848 – 26 July 1925) was a German philosopher, logician, and mathematician. Frege is widely

considered to be the greatest logician since Aristotle, and one of the most profound philosophers of mathematics ever. Though he was largely ignored during his lifetime, Giuseppe Peano (1858-1932), Bertrand Russell (1872-1970), and, to some extent, Ludwig Wittgenstein (1889-1951) introduced his work to later generations of philosophers

In the 1930s, he apprenticed with Eva Le Gallienne's Civic Repertory Theatre and worked with such influential groups as the Federal Theatre Project's Living Newspaper unit, the Mercury Theatre, and the Group Theatre. Yosef Ben-Jochannan He was considered to be one of the more prominent Afrocentric scholars by some Black Nationalists. Macbeth It dramatises the physically violent and damaging psychological effects of political ambitions and power. It was first published in the Folio of 1623, possibly from a prompt book, and is Shakespeare's shortest tragedy. Scholars believe Macbeth, of all the plays that Shakespeare wrote during the reign of King James I, contains the most allusions to James, patron of Shakespeare's acting company. As in Julius Caesar, though, perturbations in the political

sphere are echoed and even amplified. The Tragedy of Macbeth, often shortened to Macbeth, is a tragedy by William Shakespeare, estimated to have been first performed in 1606. an inversion of the natural kingship, in which he struggles

Nero was born at Antium in AD 37, the son of Gnaeus Domitius Ahenobarbus and Agrippina the Younger (great-granddaughter of the emperor Augustus). Nero was three when his father died. By the time Nero turned eleven, his mother married Emperor Claudius, who then adopted Nero as his heir. Upon Claudius' death in AD 54, Nero ascended to the throne with the backing of the Praetorian Guard and the Senate. In the early years of his reign, Nero was advised and guided by his mother Agrippina, his tutor Seneca the Younger, and his praetorian prefect Sextus Afranius... Autopsies are usually performed by a specialized medical doctor called a pathologist. Only a small portion of deaths require an autopsy to be performed, under certain circumstances. In most cases, a medical examiner or coroner can determine the cause of death. The oldest detailed description comes from Julius Caesar's Commentarii de Bello Gallico (50s BC). Their beliefs and practices are attested in some detail by their contemporaries from other cultures,

such as the Romans and the Greeks. While they were reported to have been literate, they are believed to have been prevented by doctrine from recording their knowledge in written form. Druids left no written accounts
