SCS is a consideration for people who have a pain condition that has not responded to more conservative therapy. Based on previous studies, the lead placement for patients with low back pain is typically T9 to T10. There are also spinal cord stimulators under research and development that could enable patients with spinal cord injury to walk again via epidural electrical stimulation (EES). location 7322504645
