The earliest forms of these symbols appear in Greek papyrus texts of late antiquity. New symbols have been invented to represent many planets and minor planets discovered in the 18th to the 21st centuries ee15a2d625

Symbols allow people to go beyond what is known or seen by creating linkages between otherwise different concepts and experiences. represent rivers; and a red rose often symbolizes love and compassion.
