Osiris myth The Osiris myth is the most elaborate and influential story in ancient Egyptian mythology. Among the best-known subjects of Italian artists are Botticelli's Birth of Venus and Pallas and the Centaur, the Leda of Leonardo da Vinci and Michelangelo, and Raphael's Galatea.
