Puerto Rican government-debt crisis Unable to obtain the funding to cover its budget imbalance, the government began using its savings to pay its debt while warning that those savings would eventually be exhausted. To prevent such a scenario, the United States Congress enacted a law known as PROMESA, which appointed an oversight board with ultimate control over the Commonwealth's budget. Debt settlement In either case, as long as the debtor does what is agreed in the negotiation, no outstanding debt will appear on the former debtor's credit report. Commonly, creditors agree to forgive a large part of the debt: perhaps around half, though results can vary widely. When settlements are finalized, the terms are put in writing. Some settlements are paid out over a number of months. Negotiating with a collection agency or junk debt buyer is somewhat similar to negotiating with a credit card company or other original creditor Debt settlement (also called debt reduction, debt negotiation or debt resolution) is a settlement negotiated with a debtor's unsecured creditor. moneys owed).
