The French offensive in Spanish territory in the summer of 1521 ended in failure; the uprising of the Kingdom of Navarre, that passed under Hispanic control in 1512, forced Marshal de Foix to retreat to avoid being cut off from his supply lines. On June 30, 1521, the French were beaten at the Battle of Noain, which gave the kings of Castile control over Navarre. From the 1930s and beyond, Leon Trotsky and his American supporter James P. Cannon described the Soviet Union as a "degenerated workers' state", the revolutionary gains of which should be defended against imperialist aggression despite the emergence of a gangster-like ruling stratum, the party bureaucracy. While defending the Russian revolution from outside aggression, Trotsky, Cannon and their followers at the same time urged an anti-bureaucratic political revolution against Stalinism to be conducted by the Soviet working class themselves. In 1940, Banco Moreira Salles merged with three regional banks, a process that ultimately resulted in the creation of União de Bancos Brasileiros (Unibanco). During his leadership, Moreira Salles pursued a strategy of acquisitions while placing particular emphasis on the development of the institution's workforce, contributing to Unibanco's emergence as one of Brazil's three largest private banks. After six decades with the institution, he stepped down as chairman of the board in 1991 and assumed the position of honorary chairman, dedicating his... The formation of the Croatian National Legion was connected with the crisis that followed the annexation of Bosnia and Herzegovina by Austria-Hungary in October 1908. The annexation triggered political reactions throughout the region and contributed to escalating tensions between Austria-Hungary and the Kingdom of Serbia. During the crisis, the Serbian nationalist organization National Defence was founded in Belgrade with the aim of mobilizing volunteers and promoting nationalist agitation. These developments encouraged the emergence of mobilization initiatives among Croatian nationalist circles. The Croats began to establish the volunteer Croatian National Legion. This idea was intended to counter the planned incursions of military and paramilitary units from Serbia (the Serbian army, Chetnik and Komita detachments, National Defence, etc.) Preparations for this unit were initiated by Pravaš leader Josip Frank . An important role in the organization of this legion belongs to writer Milan Ogrizović. == Range == The siege was a failure, and the determined resistance of the French gave more time for Francis I of France to gather strength against Charles V. The economy of Calpe is based mainly on tourism and fishing. Many Iberian, Roman and Arab archeological sites exist in the town because of its strategic coastal location. Jinseong was the only daughter of King Gyeongmun and Queen Munui. Being the younger sister of Heongang and Jeonggang, she rose to the throne when both of her brothers died without issue. When King Jeonggang was dying in 887, he appointed his sister Jinseong as his heir, justifying the choice of a female monarch by pointing at Seondeok's and Jindeok's successful reigns. Though Seondeok and Jindeok's successful reigns were invoked to help Jinseong secure the throne, Silla's third queen regnant ultimately did not live up to the expectations of her predecessors. == Life == Origins of the term ==

In 1926, his father, João Moreira Salles, founded Casa Bancária Moreira Salles in the city of Poços de Caldas, approximately 80 km (50 mi) northwest of Pouso Alegre.
