

Trig Reference Sheet

Mynydd Merthyr It forms the boundary between the unitary authorities of Rhondda Cynon Taff to the west and Merthyr Tydfil to the east. The high point of 493m is at Mynydd Gethin (OS grid reference SO 044025) (though the summit trig point is at the lower height of 491m) is the culmination Mynydd Merthyr is a broad ridge of high ground between Taff Vale (Welsh Cwm Taf) and the Cwm Cynon in the Valleys region of South Wales 1bbb6af050

Much of the hill has been planted with coniferous forest. Its flanks are heavily scarred by mining. The village of Aberfan sits at the foot of its eastern slopes... 1bbb6af050

Benchmarking (hobby) In the United Kingdom, "trig-pointing" is a recreational activity similar to benchmarking. Like geocaching, the activity has become popular since 1995, propelled by the availability of online data on the location of survey marks (with directions for finding them) and by the rise of hobbyist-oriented websites. Searching for trig points is more popular than hunting Benchmarking, also known as benchmark hunting, is a hobby activity in which participants find benchmarks (also known as survey markers or geodetic control points). The term "benchmark" is used only to refer to survey markers that designate a certain elevation, but hobbyists often use the term benchmarks to include triangulation stations or other reference marks. outcrop 1bbb6af050

Horsenden Hill It is the site of a trig point, TP4024. summit forms part of the site of an ancient hillfort. The base of this isolated hill is at an altitude of approximately Horsenden Hill (; grid reference TQ 161 843) is a hill and open space, located between the Perivale, Sudbury, and Greenford areas of West London. It is in the London Borough of Ealing, close to the boundary with the London Borough of Brent. It is one of the higher eminences in the local area, rising to 85 m (276 ft) above sea level, and the summit forms part of the site of an ancient hillfort. It is the site of a trig point, TP4024 1bbb6af050

Cribarth The summit lies on the broken ridge at an elevation of 428 m (1,404 ft) at OS grid reference SN 831143. Both of these latter high points are adorned by Bronze Age burial Cribarth (nicknamed the Sleeping Giant) is a hill in the Brecon Beacons National Park, Powys, Wales, in the traditional county of Brecknockshire. Both of these latter high points are adorned by Bronze Age burial cairns. height of 423 m (1,388 ft) at its southwest end and this spot is marked by a trig point. To its west is a 426-metre-

high (1,398 ft) rounded top at SN 829144 which lies just to the northwest of a mile-long ridge that forms the main bulk of the hill. The ridge attains a height of 423 m (1,388 ft) at its southwest end and this spot is marked by a trig point 1bbb6af050

Fan Gyhirych It lies within the county of Breconshire, and administered as part of the unitary authority of Powys. The Fan Gyhirych is a mountain in the Fforest Fawr section of Brecon Beacons National Park in south Wales. authority of Powys. Its highest point at 2379 feet (or 725 m) is marked by a trig point which is located towards the western side of the summit plateau 1bbb6af050

Plackweghöhe 5 m above sea level (NHN) and lies within the counties of Soest and Hochsauerlandkreis. The Lörmecke Tower observation tower at the top is a popular destination. It is 581. kilometres away. The highest point is shown on commercial maps just as an unnamed trig point, even though it is the summit of a hill range in the Central Uplands The Plackweghöhe ("Plackweg Heights"), whose main summit has hitherto had no official name, is the highest point in the borough of Warstein, the hill ridge of the Plackwald, the North Sauerland Uplands, and the Arnsberg Forest Nature Park in the German state of North Rhine-Westphalia 1bbb6af050

The high point of 493m is at Mynydd Gethin (OS grid reference SO 044025) (though the summit trig point is at the lower height of 491m) is the culmination of a long ridge which extends northwestwards from the confluence of the Afon Cynon and the River Taff at Abercynon. The ridge includes the subsidiary summits of Twyn Brynbychan and Twyn Sych. To the northwest lies Mynydd Aberdâr. 1bbb6af050

Grey Knotts There are also several small tarns on the summit as well as some fence Grey Knotts is a fell in the English Lake District. the fell twin tops of equal height, the eastern top has an Ordnance Survey trig point. It is situated one kilometre (2/3 mile) south of the B5289 road as it crosses the Honister Pass. Grey Knotts reaches a height of 697 metres (2,287 feet) and is part of a ridge which ascends from the woodland behind Seatoller and continues south-west and then south for four kilometres to Great Gable. The fell's name really only applies to the summit rocks, but has been adopted for the entire fell with the high ground in this area, locally known as Seatoller Fell on Ordnance Survey maps. It is well seen from mid-Borrowdale as it rises above Seatoller 1bbb6af050

The broad-topped ridge runs NNW-SSE and achieves a summit height of 550 metres (1,800 ft) at a point crowned by a trig point at OS grid ref SO 187084 between Ebbw Vale and Blaina. It is a Marilyn with a prominence of 176 metres. 1bbb6af050

Mynydd Carn-y-cefn achieves a summit height of 550 metres (1,800 ft) at a point crowned by a trig point at OS grid ref SO 187084

between Ebbw Vale and Blaina. It is a Marilyn Mynydd Carn-y-cefn (grid reference SO1808) is the name given to the broad ridge of high ground between the Ebbw Vale and the valley of the Ebbw Fach in the Valleys region of South Wales. It lies within the county borough of Blaenau Gwent, formerly Monmouthshire 1bbb6af050

Its highest point at 2379 feet (or 725 m) is marked by a trig point which is located towards the western side of the summit plateau. The hill drains to the north into the catchment of the Afon Crai and to the south and west into that of the River Tawe. Fan Fraith is a nearby hill which can be considered a subsidiary top of Fan Gyhirych. 1bbb6af050

Haddon Hill A couple of public footpaths traverse the hill north-south whilst numerous tracks run along its length. The larger part of the hill is within the national park, the boundary of which runs along the B3190 road which runs diagonally. It lies on the south-eastern fringe of Exmoor National Park though is separated from the Exmoor massif itself by the valleys of the rivers Haddeo and Exe The highest point of the ridge at OS grid reference SS 962286 is crowned by a trig point at 1,164 feet (355 m) above sea level. Much of the upper part of the hill is mapped as open access under the Countryside and Rights of Way Act 2000 and hence available for public access on foot. Much of the Haddon Hill is a prominent east-west aligned ridge in west Somerset, England, close to Hartford within the civil parish of Brompton Regis. Haddeo and Exe The highest point of the ridge at OS grid reference SS 962286 is crowned by a trig point at 1,164 feet (355 m) above sea level 1bbb6af050

Crug Mawr The peak sits high above the valleys of the Grwyne Fawr and Grwyne Crug Mawr is a hill in the Black Mountains in the Brecon Beacons National Park in southern Powys, Wales. Its summit at a height of 550 m (1,805 ft) is marked by a trig point. The views from here across the Black Mountains are wide-ranging and also extend eastwards across Monmouthshire. Four ridges run off to the northwest, east, southeast and southwest, the last ending in the subsidiary summit of Blaen-yr-henbant. Powys, Wales. The peak sits high above the valleys of the Grwyne Fawr and Grwyne Fechan to the north of the more well-known Sugar Loaf. Its summit at a height of 550 m (1,805 ft) is marked by a trig point 1bbb6af050
